3. Public comments

Mrs Maureen Hopkins spoke on the significance of the Millennium Green and what the future holds for this important green space in the heart of the village

Great Lumley Millennium Green was funded along with 250 others around the UK via funding from the National Lottery and the Millennium commission to celebrate the dawn of a new millennium in 2000.

The land, which is owned by the Parish Council was placed on a long term lease of 1000 years and the Millennium Green Trust details of which can be found on the charities commission website https://register-of-charities.charitycommission.gov.uk/charity-search/charity-details/3949721.

The funding carried with it a 40 year monitoring caveat which is now carried out by Natural England commencing in 1999 with a necessity to retain the space as a public open space until the 40 years has expired with a penalty of refunding the grant monies for non compliance.

The trustees and Friends of the Green have worked hard over several decades to maintain and improve the area as a community asset however with a shift away from this type of project being a priority for funders, monies have become scarcer and following the pandemic, the availability of trustees has left the remaining two in a very difficult position

The Parish Council is looking into whether it would be prudent to take over the project for the remaining period and what liabilities they would encounter by doing so.
